Planning Submission later than anriticpated in SOBC programme. Scrutiny of decision following selection of preferred route for Southern Link Road (SLR) by cabinet at end 2014 resulted in a later date for submission of planning application for the preferred route. This scrutiny will ensure a robust route selection process can be demonstrated.

Submission of planning application in May 2015 means original date of determination by August 2015 could not be achieved. Responses to planning application consultation has required some additional design work to respond and subsequent reconsultation. Detailed discussions with key stakeholders has followed to provide further clarification and consideration of further mitigation measures. Planning determination is currently scheduled for 6 June 2016. This results in a later date for confirmation start opening dates have been adjusted accordingly and spend profile revised. Programme revised to take account of data collection in Spring 2016 and subsequent additional modelling work.
